

CIVY BOY ONE-MODEL CONTEST RULES

“BORSETTI FORMULA”

This formula comes from an idea of one Ferrara's Ala Azurra club member, Gianni Borsetti that wanted a simple, amusing, and crowded competition using .049 engines and a one-model design he liked: the Civy Boy 24". He enlarged it multiplying the original drawings, ending in 98,3cm wingspan, that is the allowed size. This event was (and continues to be) a real success and is being held for the fourth year in a row as an annual championship through 4 contests. We, as organizers of 17th SAM Eurochamps want to include it as an outstanding competition paying tribute to Gianni's nice idea.

The contest is reserved to one model only: Civy Boy 24" enlarged to **98,3cm** wingspan; actual enlarged drawings to the allowed size are available as .pdf files from SAM62.

Only deviation from original design admitted are: replacement of solid balsa stab with a built-up structure and fuselage reinforcement. General design outlines must be kept without changes.

Engines allowed are any type/brand of GLOW engines up to **.049 (0,8cc)** displacement with an external and visible tank made from a transparent plastic syringe with a usable capacity of **3cc**. Any non-folding and non-metallic propeller is allowed. Any fuel without gasoline (petrol/benzene) is allowed. No minimal wing loading required.

Contest score will be the sum of the four best flights of five **10 minutes** maximum flights.

All other contest rules are according to present SAM Europe rules.
